Dr. N. Hemalatha, Honorable Principal of Sardar Patel College apprised the audience about the history and legacy of Sardar Patel College. She appreciated the seminar theme on *Revamping, Revitalizing, and Re-imaging Public Administration in the 21st Century; Issues, Challenges, and Prospects* and described it as an attempt towards bringing the reliable solutions for common problems. He stressed upon today in the era of globalization, governments alone are not working for effective functioning of the state. The different service providers from within the states and outside the states are involved in the policy process and in the public administration. The governance of this pattern is known as the Neo Liberal Model of Governance, which has been challenged on several grounds. In this background, there is a need to institutionalize such a collaborative mechanism consisting of government, civil society and market which can address the larger interest of society.



Dr. Sandeep Inampudi, in his address, argued that today's governance is very complex. In such a complex system where several players
