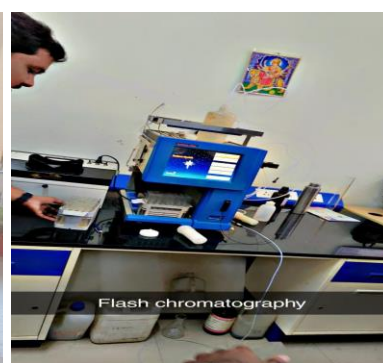


ACADEMIC FOCUS

Department of Chemistry

Industrial visit to NIPER

The industrial visit to NIPER Hyderabad has been organized on 9th February, 2024. Prof. Nanduri Srinivas, Head, Dept of Chemical Sciences coordinated and helped with the trip. Twenty eight students of M.Sc I and II years, Dr. T. D. Neelima along with other faculty members visited NIPER-Hyderabad. The concerned faculty Dr. Jitendra Madan, HoD of Pharmaceutics department was assigned to brief about the planning of the tour. There are four departments at NIPER, Hyderabad viz. Pharmaceutics, Pharmaceutical Analysis, Chemical Sciences, Pharmacology, and toxicology. The students were divided into three groups, led by few research scholars like Mr. Srikanth and Mr. Harshil at NIPER to take the group on tour around the institution. Students and faculty members were able to interact with research scholars and eminent staff and also learn about vast instrumentation facility that includes Infra Red spectrophotometer, UV spectrophotometer, NMR, Scanning Electron Microscope, dissolution tanks, IR pellet maker, HPLC, GC, rotavapors, fumehoods, icemaking machines, and invivo and in vitro labs. Weighing instruments that could weigh upto 0.001 micrograms. This weighing machine is especially used for weighing the impurities in a drug. Dr. Nandkumar took the team around their animal facility at NIPER, which provides for the in vivo studies. The HOD, chemical sciences Dr. Nanduri invited the faculty members and suggested to foster a cordial relationship between NIPER and Sardar Patel College in future for useful intellectual inputs from NIPER and to organize industrial visits, extension lectures, summer internships etc. Students also were made aware of the possibility to get admission for a PhD. with valid GATE and NIPER-JEE Scores. The visit has been a very productive, useful and informative one for all the students and faculty members. NIPER extended their excellent hospitality all through the visit.

INDUSTRIAL VISIT

Department of Business Management organized Industrial visit to Hindustan beverages Pvt.Ltd located in Miyapur and Vijaya Dairy Farm located in Lalapet for the students of MBA I & II YEAR, BBA FINAL YEAR on April 29th 2024. The visit is aimed to provide insights into the company's products and services, the structure of various departments, and the innovative techniques used to manage its operations and also to provide opportunities to students to learn and foster professional development and growth. 106 students accompanied by four faculty members visited the industry and Dairy farm. Students were taken around the beverage industry and were explained the process of production and also the strategies of marketing. The students were also taken to Vijaya Dairy and witnessed the processing and pasteurization of milk and other dairy products. They also explained how the distribution partners worked and other mechanisms of marketing. It was a study cum fun trip for the students.



Department of Life Sciences

Visit to Nursery Mela

Students from B.Sc IIIrd & IInd year along with two faculty members and lab assistants visited Nursery Mela held at people's plaza, Necklace road on 3rd February 2024. Students learned about various propagating techniques of different plants and they got an opportunity to practically look at a few rare species like Bonsai, Orchids and various other plants. They also learned about various species of the succulents and ornamentals like chrysanthemum, rose, gerbera, petunia and techniques involved in growing such plants.



Outreach programme

The Department of life sciences has organized an outreach programme for the 8th, 9th & 10th class students of government girls high school picket, west marredpally on 5th february 2024. Students from B.Sc life sciences along with lab assistants and faculty took part in the outreach programme and practically demonstrated various experiments for the students. Simple experiments like stages of mitosis were demonstrated from onion root tips, blood grouping was done for about 50 students. The main aim of this programme is to raise awareness about life sciences and to grasp the interest of the students by practically demonstrating the experiments.



World Pulses Day

The Department of Botany has organized an event on 10th February 2024 on the account of “World Pulses Day”. The main aim of this event is to bring awareness among the students and the staff about the importance of pulses and their nutritional value. Students from all the streams participated in various events organized by the department.

Special National Integration Camp (SNIC), Assam - 01/02/2024 to 12/02/2024

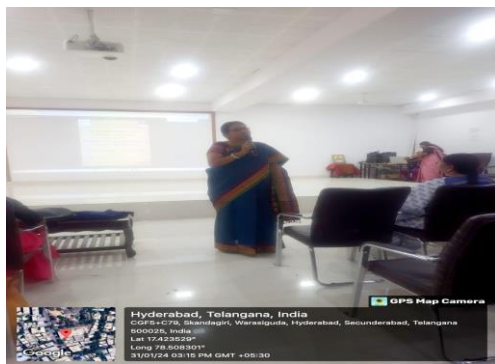

Report of Youth Peace Foundation

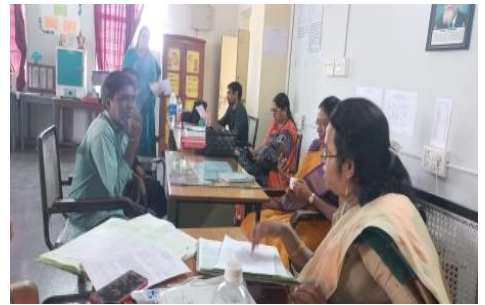
