Result of Analysis of Students' Feedback Regarding the Review of Curriculum (2023-2024)

For the enrichment of the students the college provides its best possible learning environment. To enhance the quality of teaching & learning experience, Students' feedback related to curriculum is very important. This provides us with valuable suggestions for further improvement of the curriculum.

Methodology

The feedback from students is design and review from the curriculum which was obtained through Structured Questionnaire which included 10 questions on various aspects of curriculum.

A five point Likert scale has been used with weights assigned from 1 to 5 of different levels as follows:

1- Strongly Disagree

2- Disagree

3- Neutral

4- Agree

5- Strongly Agree

The Range of each order level is determined by the following formula:

(Highest point in Likert Scale- Lowest point in Likert Scale)/ Number of Levels Used

Therefore, Range= $(5-1)/5=4/5=0.8$

Hence,

Range for 'Strongly Disagree' is 1.0 to 0

Range for 'Disagree' is 1.0 to 1.1

Range for 'Neutral' is 1.3 to 1.5

Range for 'Agree' is 4.2 to 4.5

Range for 'Strongly Agree' is 4.8 to 5.0

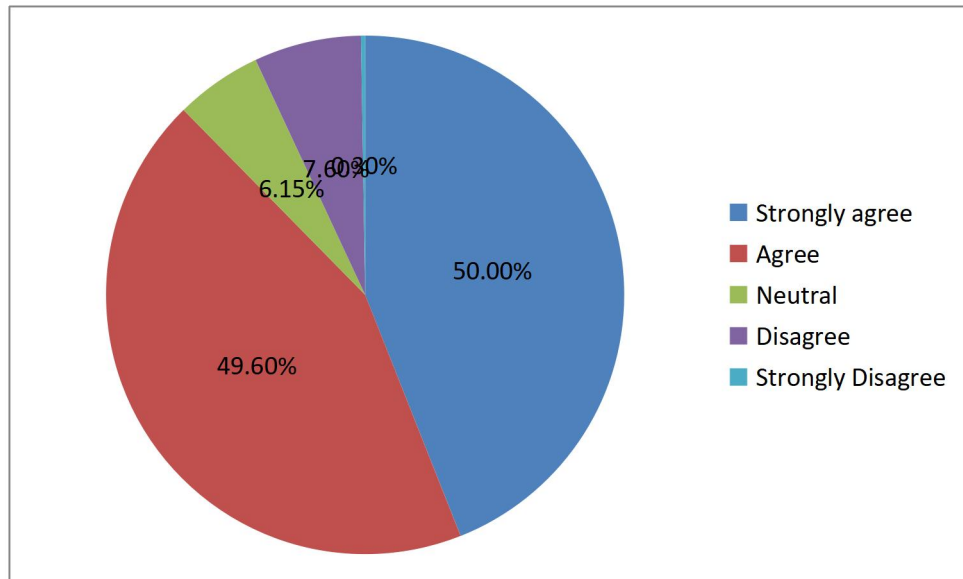


Fig.1. Percentage of responses on coverage of the relevant topics in curriculum for the assigned subjects.

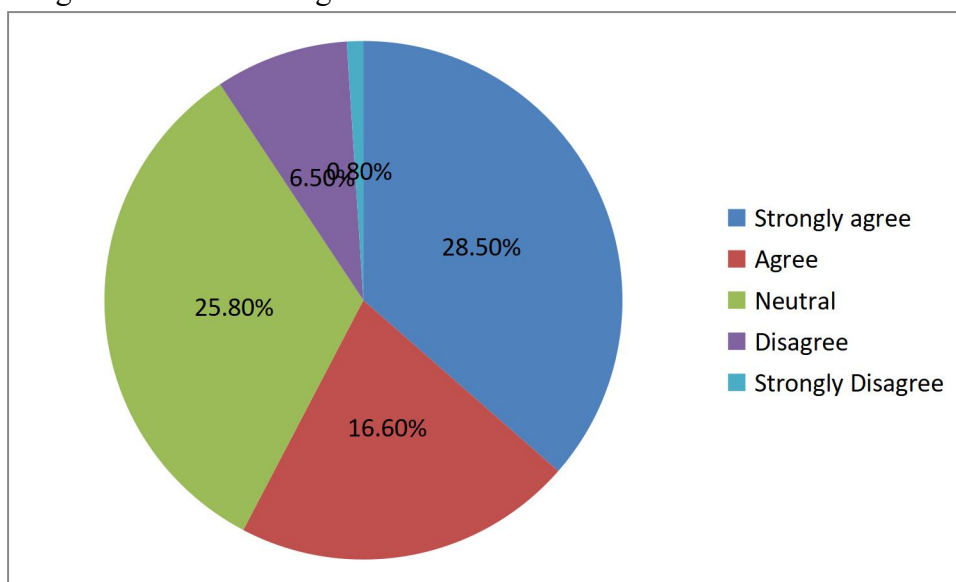


Fig.2. Percentage of responses on coverage of the all the relevant books & Reference materials according to the Subjects are available in the college library.

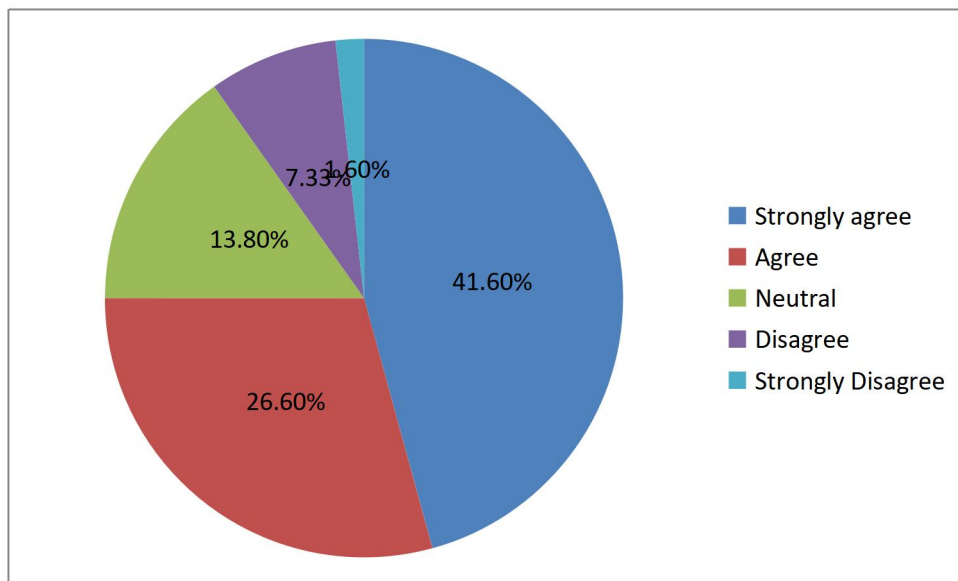


Fig.3. Percentage of responses on coverage of the all the entire syllabus is covered in the allotted time period.

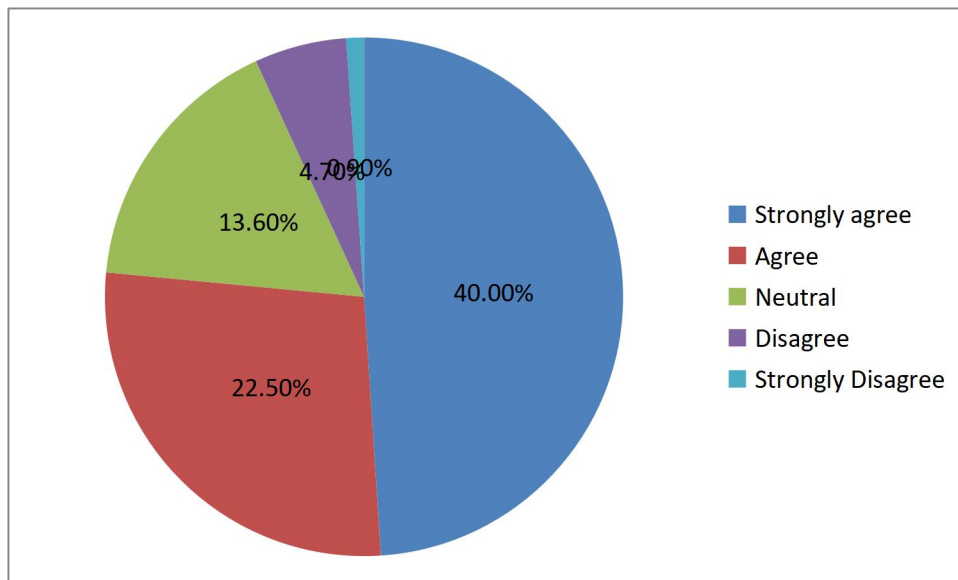


Fig.4. Percentage of responses on coverage of the all the curriculum recent improvisation added regularly.

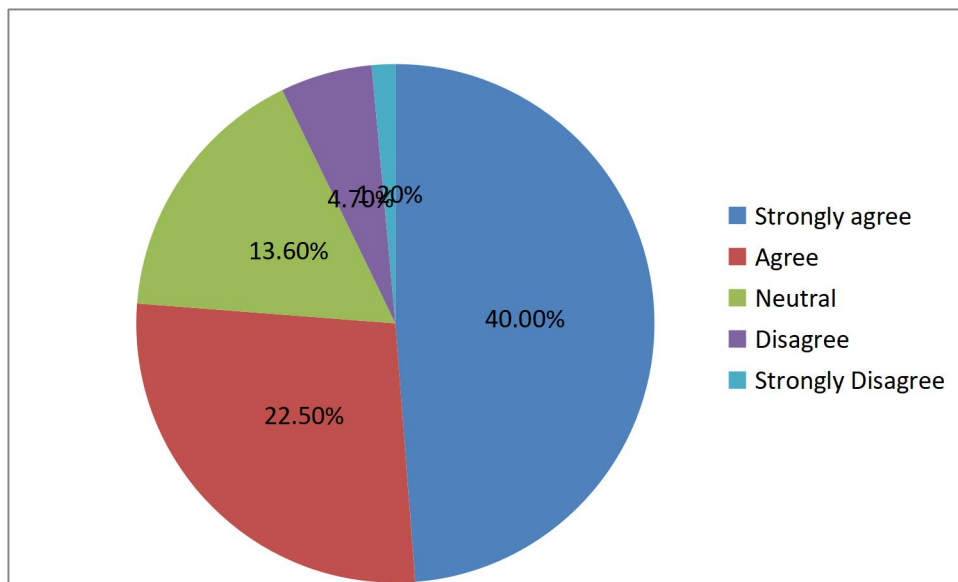
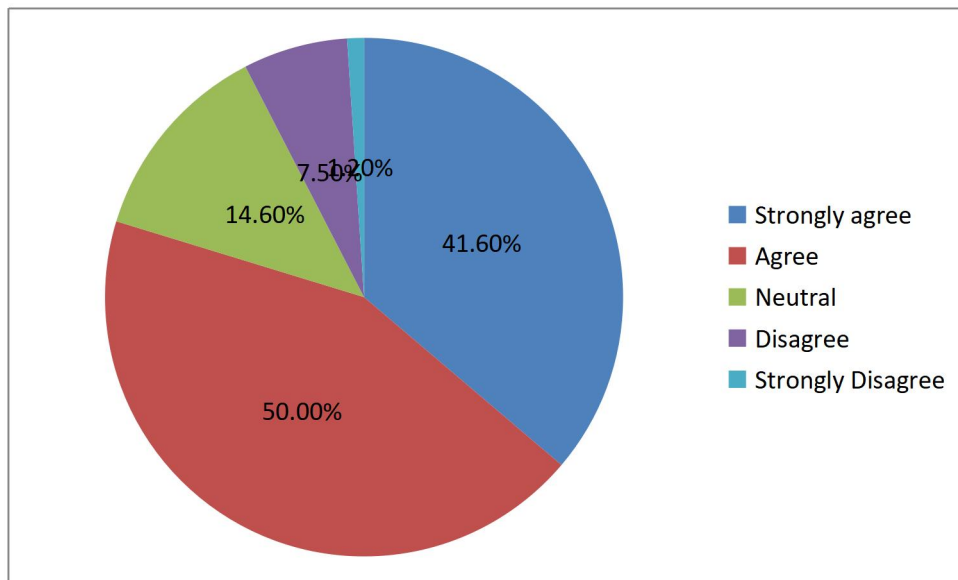


Fig.5. Percentage of responses on coverage of the all the curriculum has gained knowledge, skills& competencies.

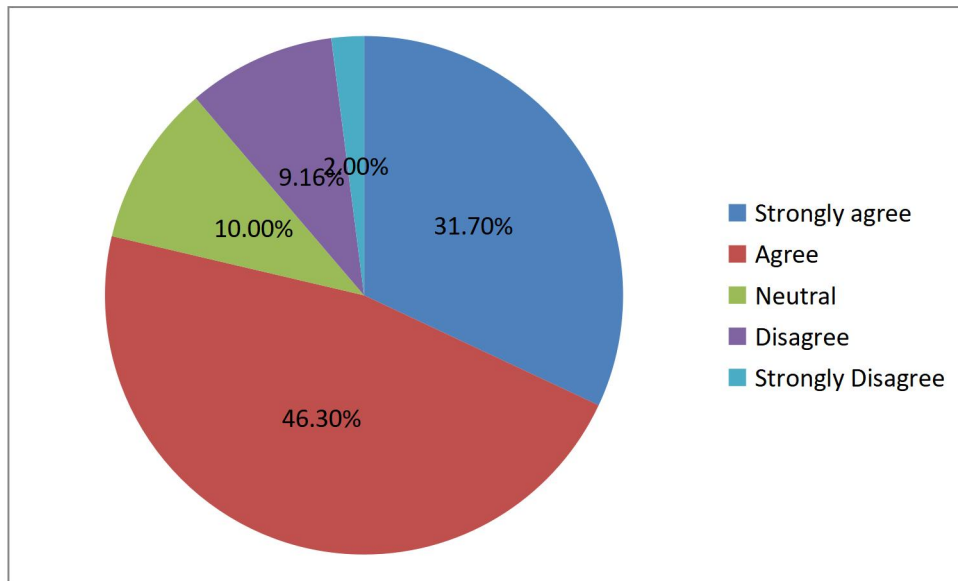


Fig 7 The syllabus is designed to enhance the employability skills of the students.

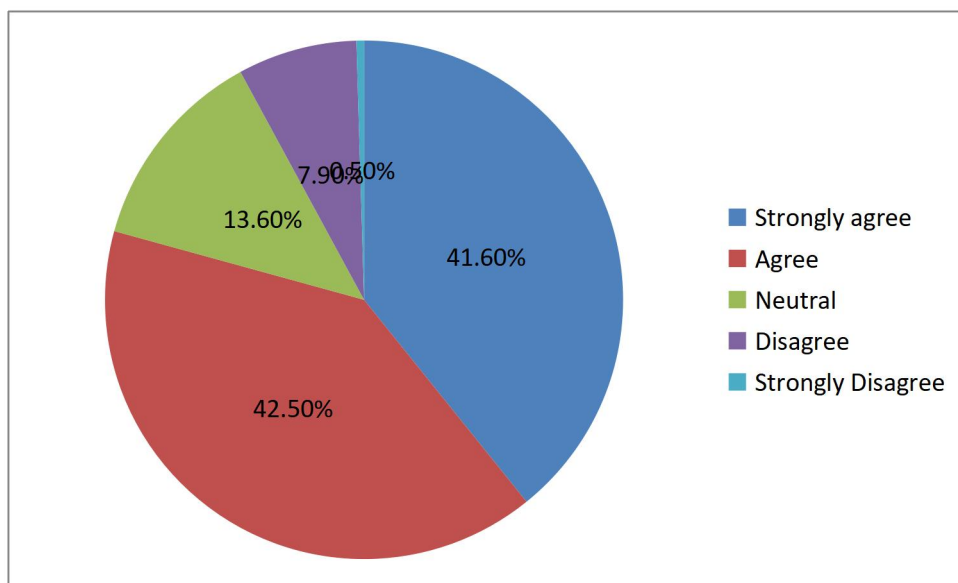


Fig.8 The College has adequate ICT facilities to cover the syllabus.

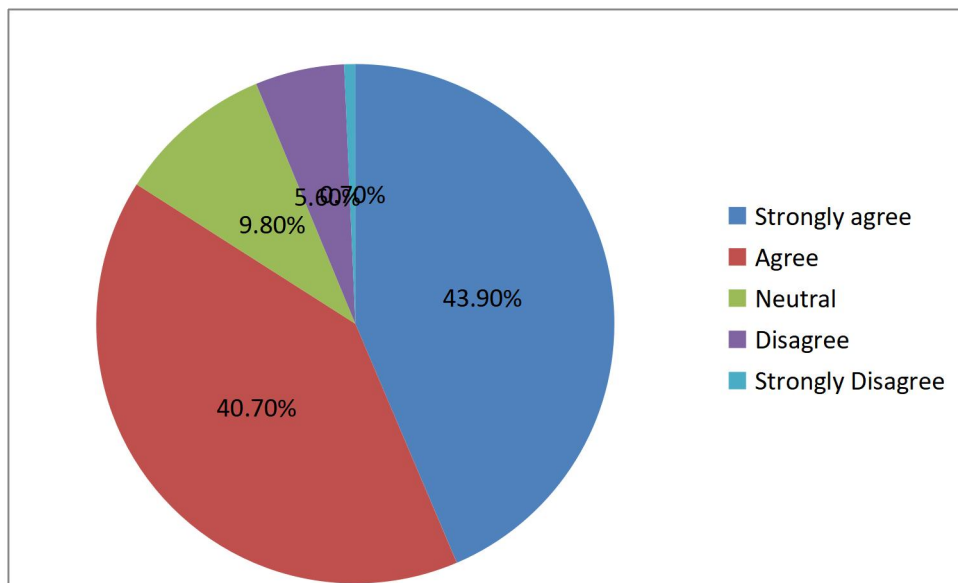


Fig.9 Have you gained knowledge during the course.

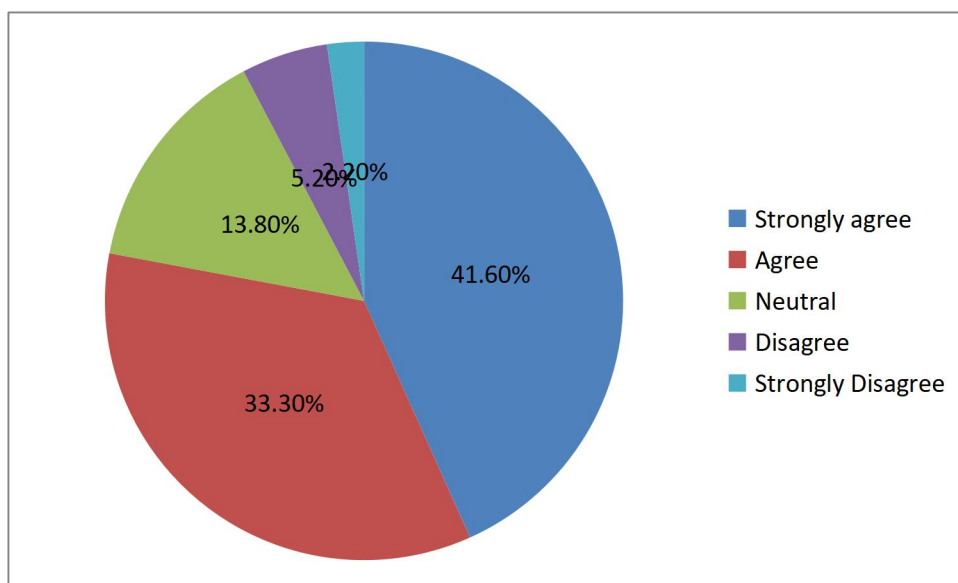


Fig.10 Difficulty level of the syllabus is justified in the practice

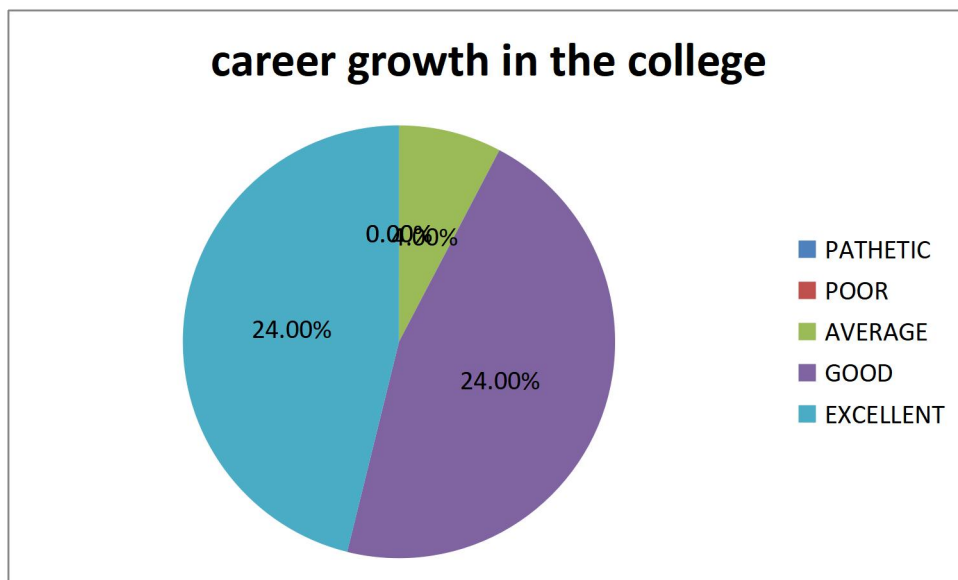

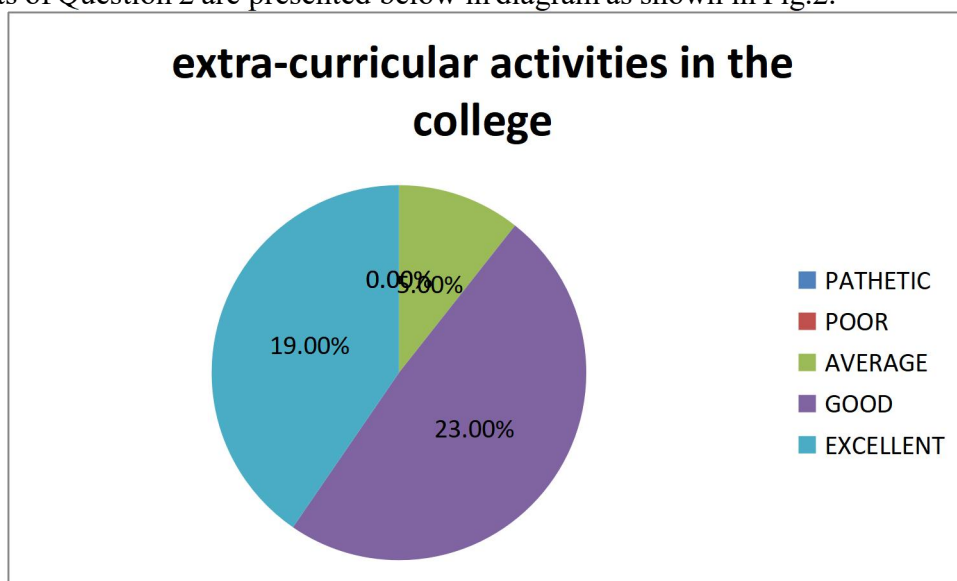

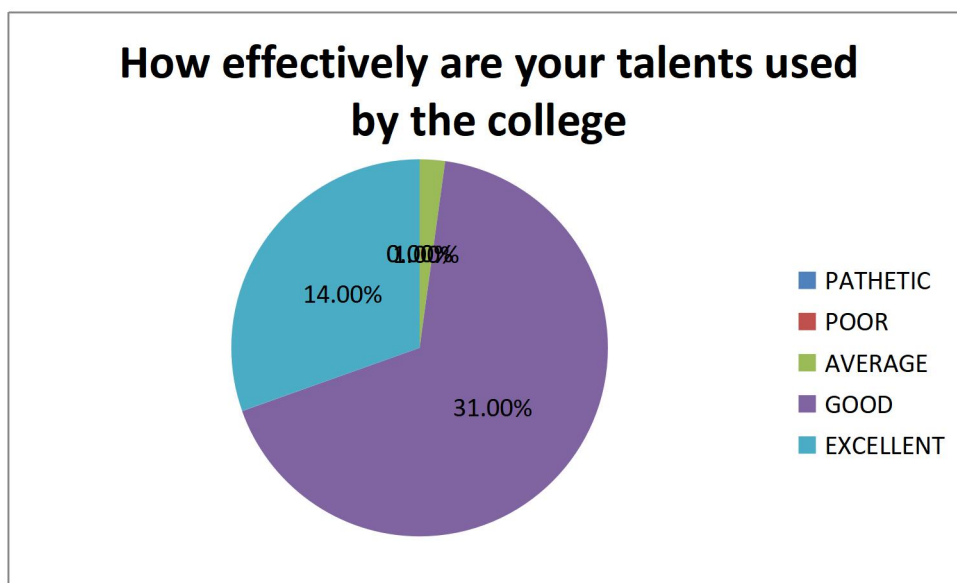

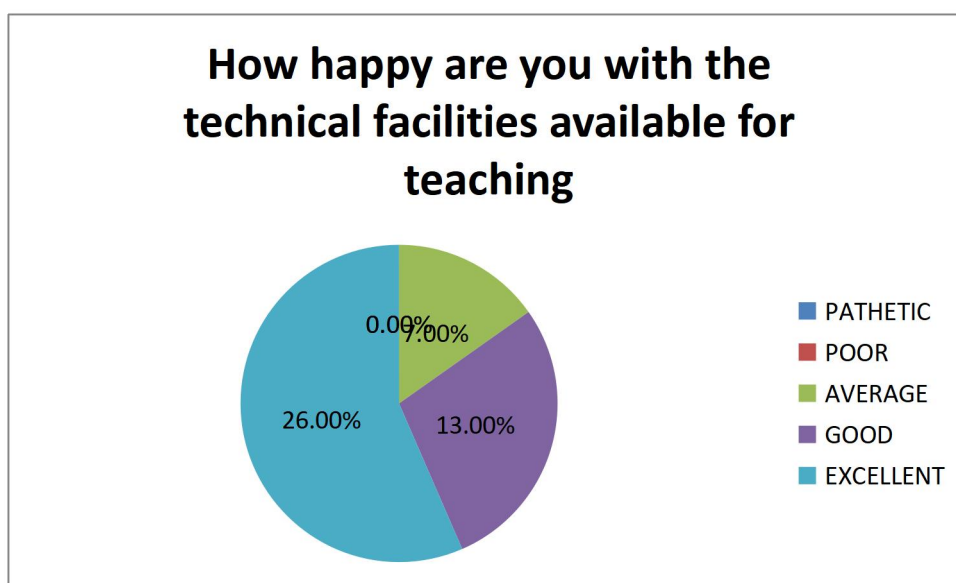

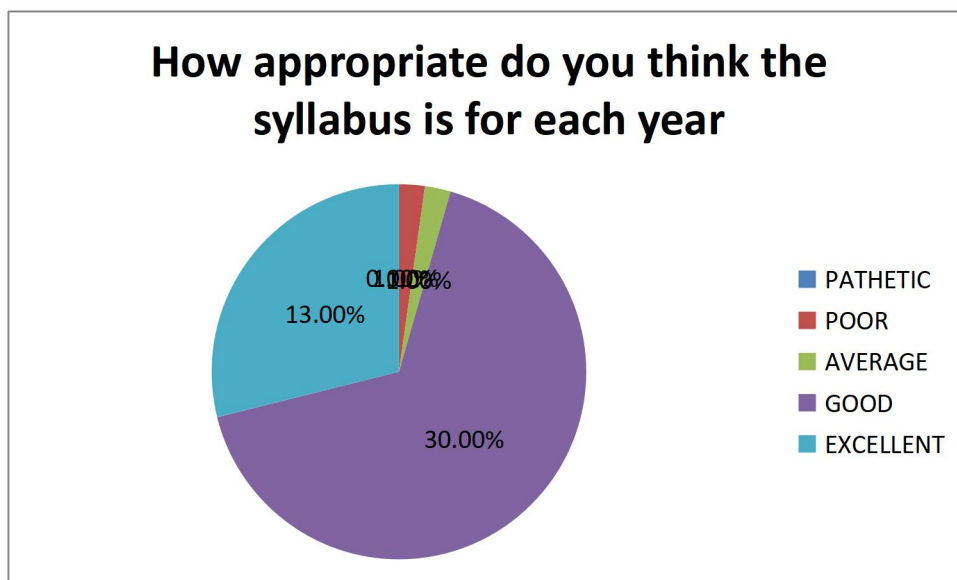

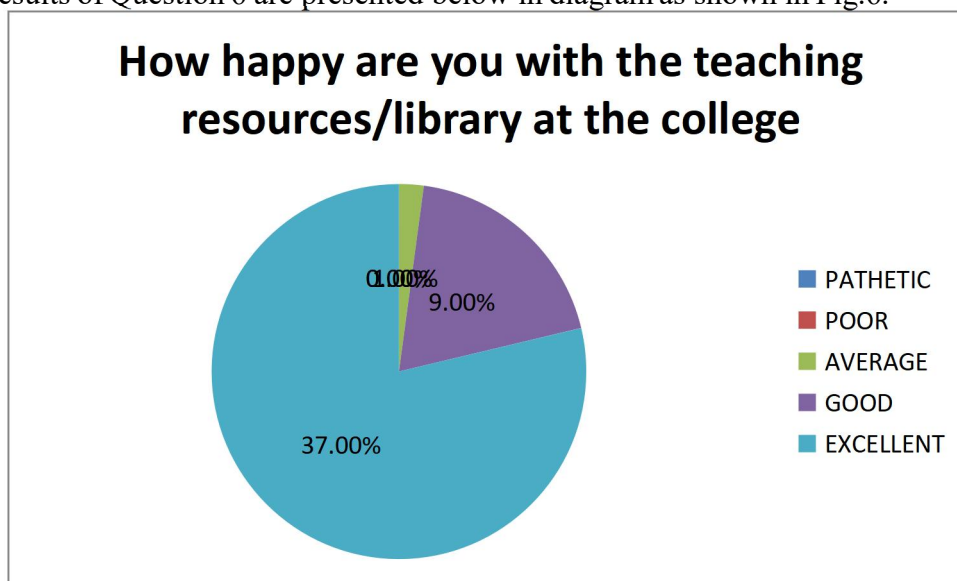


Fig 6 The syllabus is designed to explain your teaching goals and learning outcome.

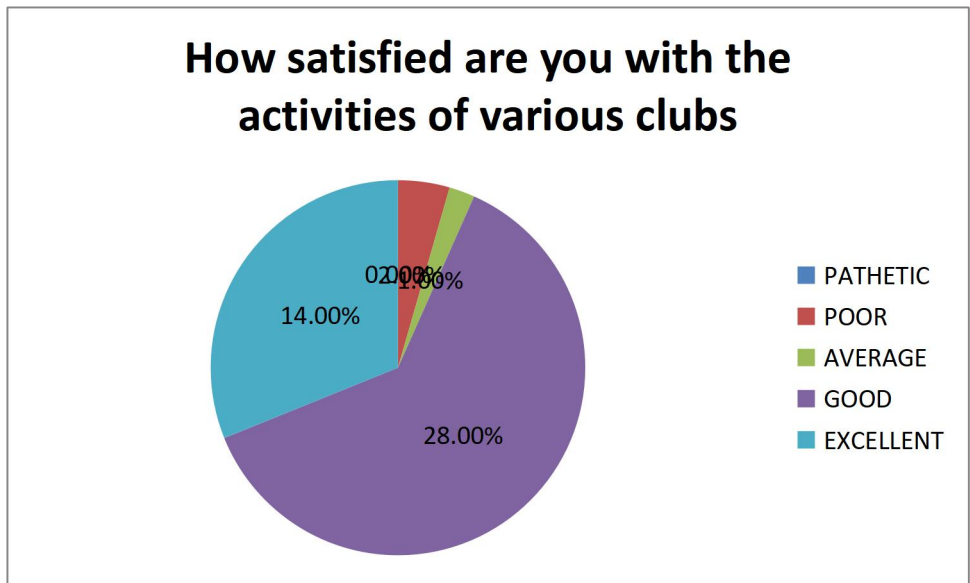


Fig7 The syllabus is designed to explain your teaching goals and learning outcome.

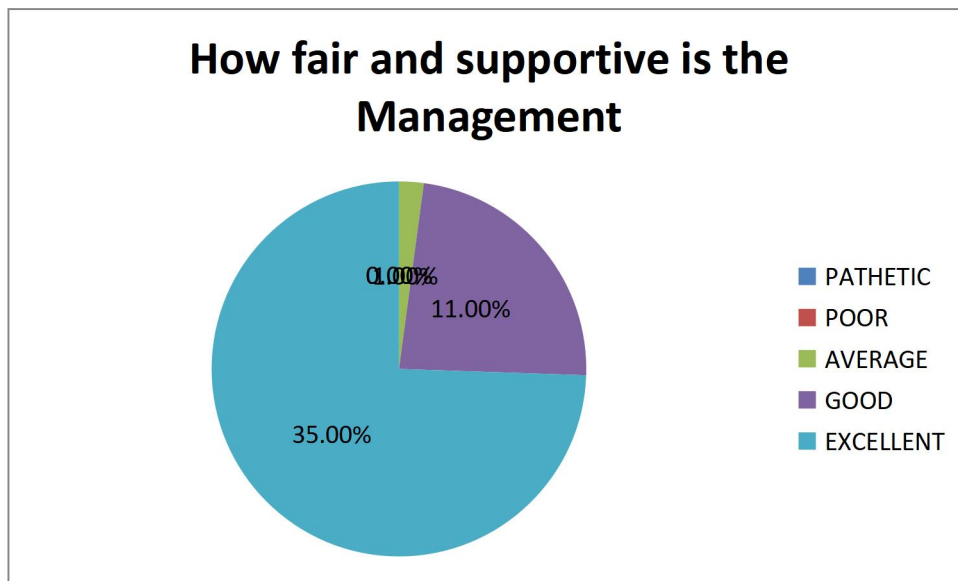

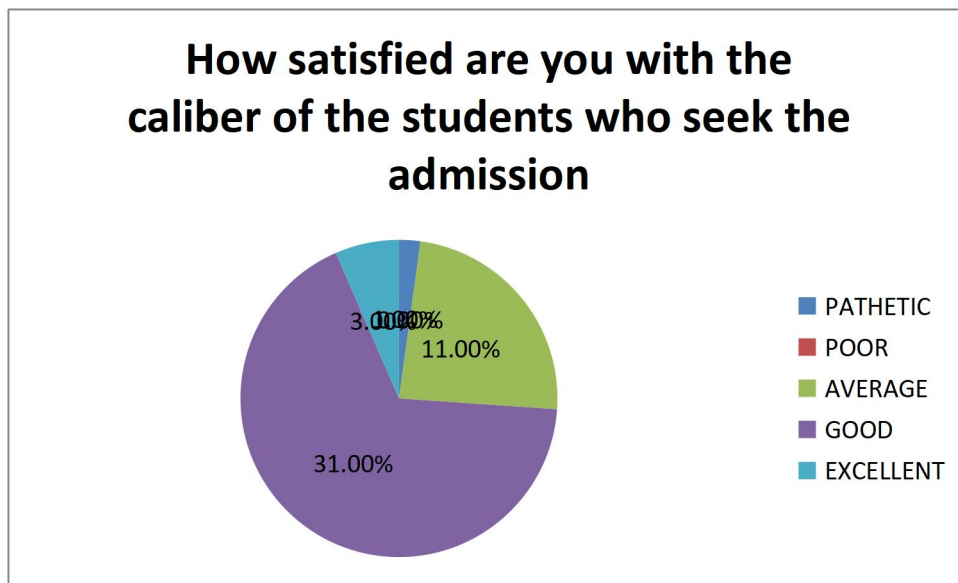

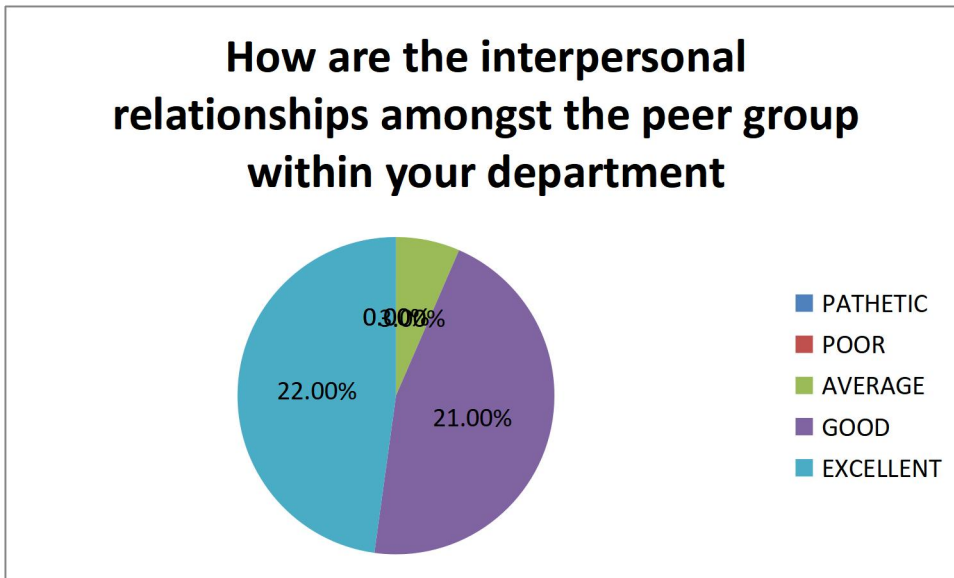

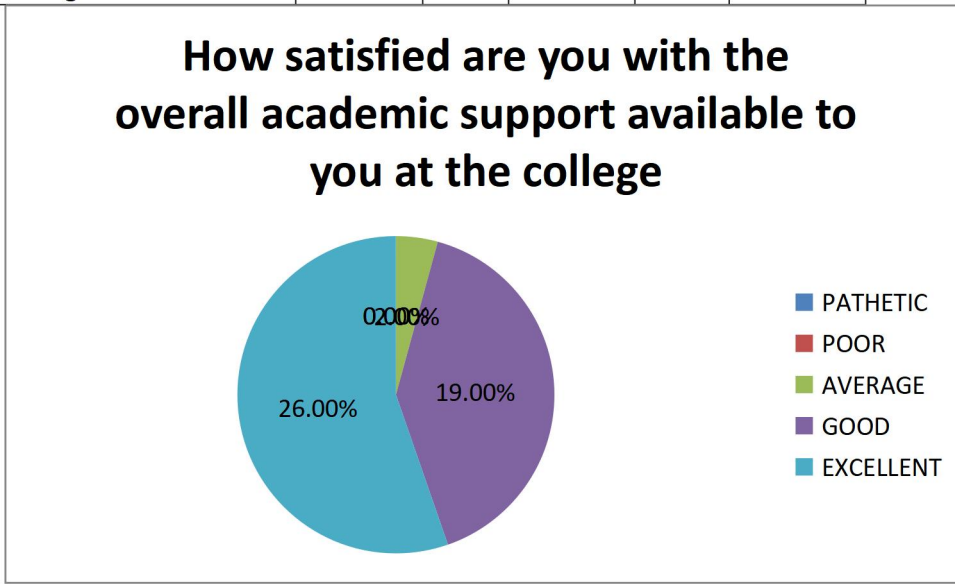

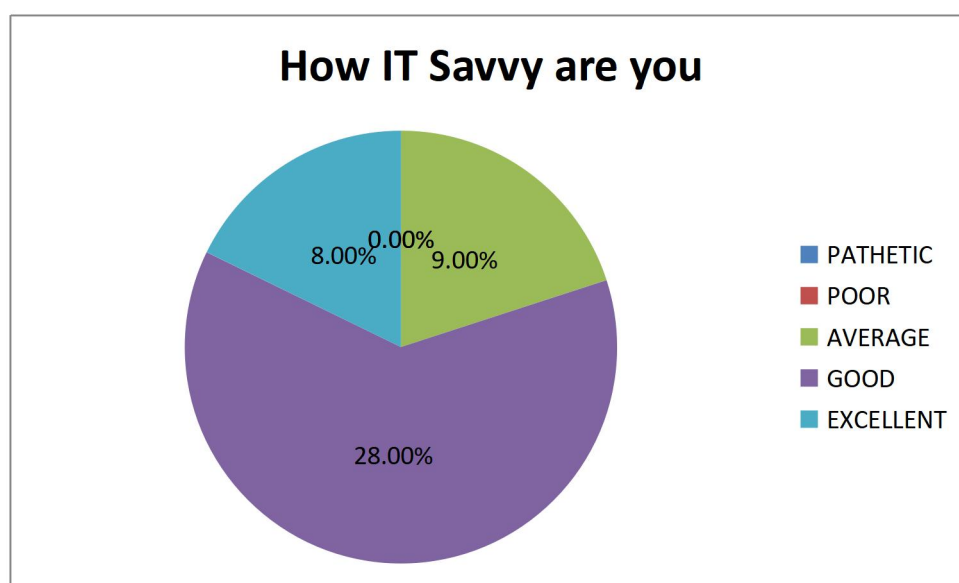

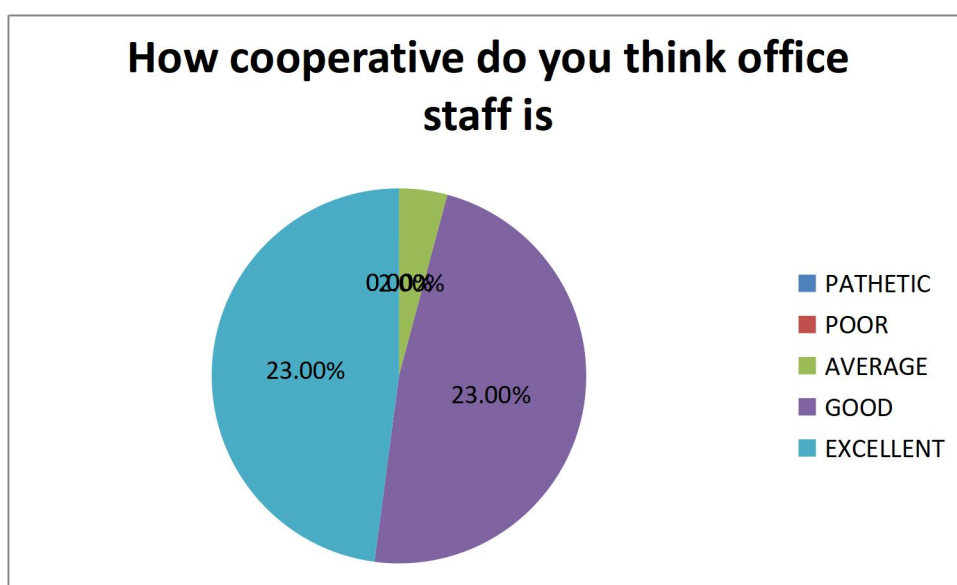

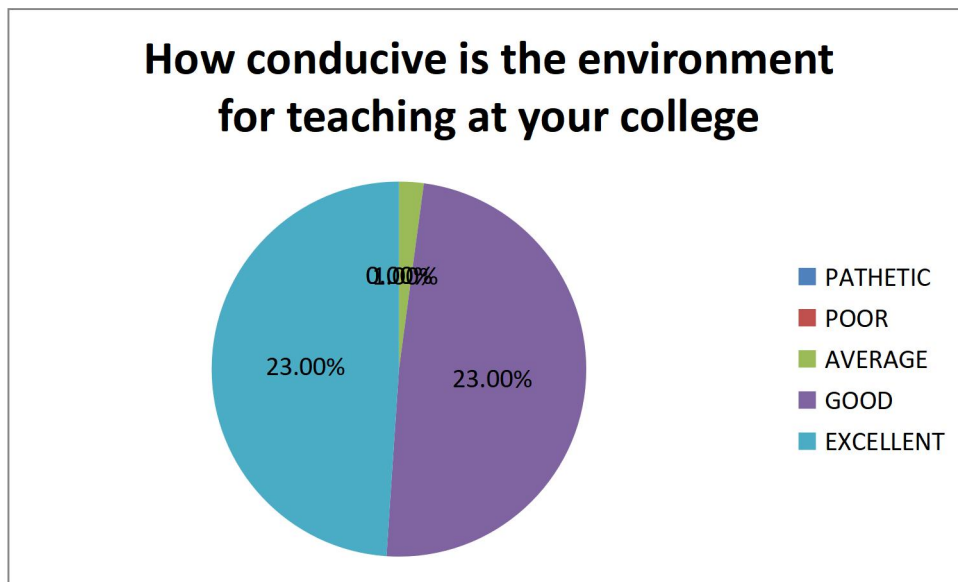

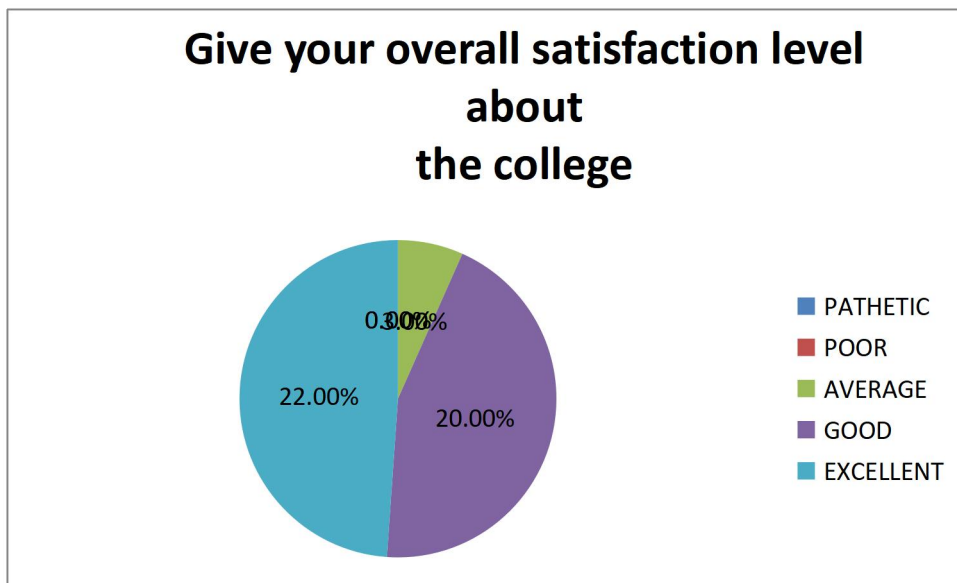

REPORT ON ANALYSIS OF FEEDBACK ON CURRICULUM

College collects the feedback on curriculum aspects and courses. The feedback form procedure runs through the combination of UG & PG groups. It also assists in improving and further developing the teaching methods.

Methodology

The feedback from employers on designing and review of curriculum and college infrastructure was obtained through Structured Questionnaire which included 10 questions on various aspects of curriculum and college infrastructure.

A five point Likert scale has been used with weights assigned from 1 to 5 to different levels as follows:

- 1- Strongly Agree
- 2- Agree
- 3- Neutral
- 4- Disagree
- 5- Strongly Disagree

The Range of each order or level is determined by the following formula:

$(\text{Highest point in Likert Scale} - \text{Lowest point in Likert Scale}) / \text{Number of Levels Used}$

Therefore Range = $(5-1)/5=4/5=0.8$

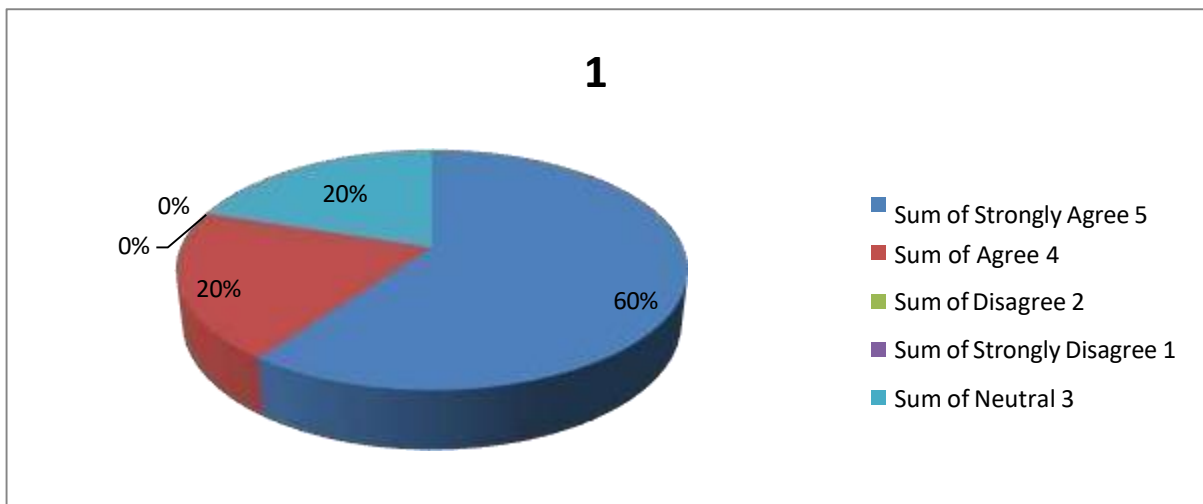


Figure 1 - Percentage of responses of employers about General Communication Skills.

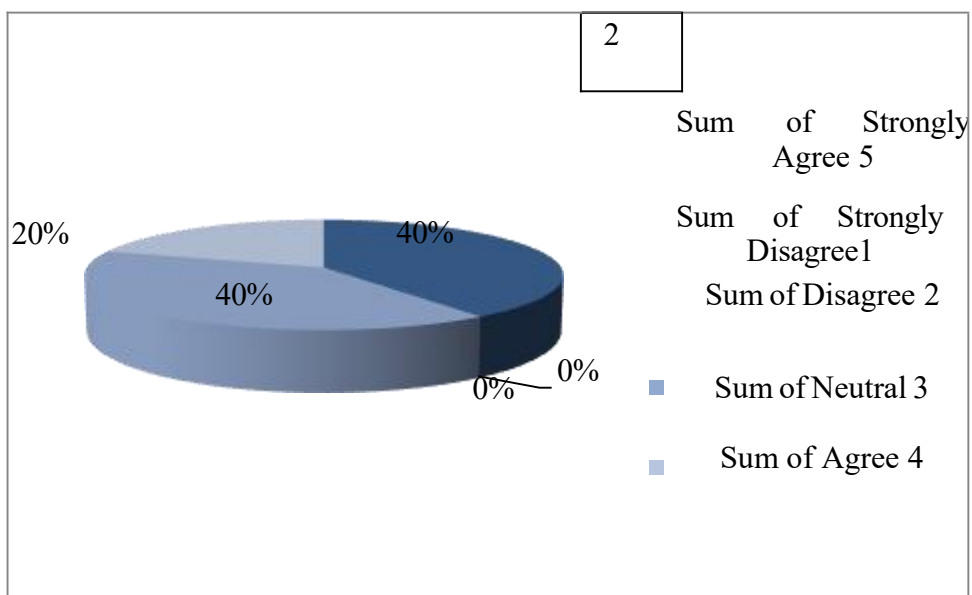


Figure 2 - Percentage of responses of employers about Open to new ideas and learning new techniques

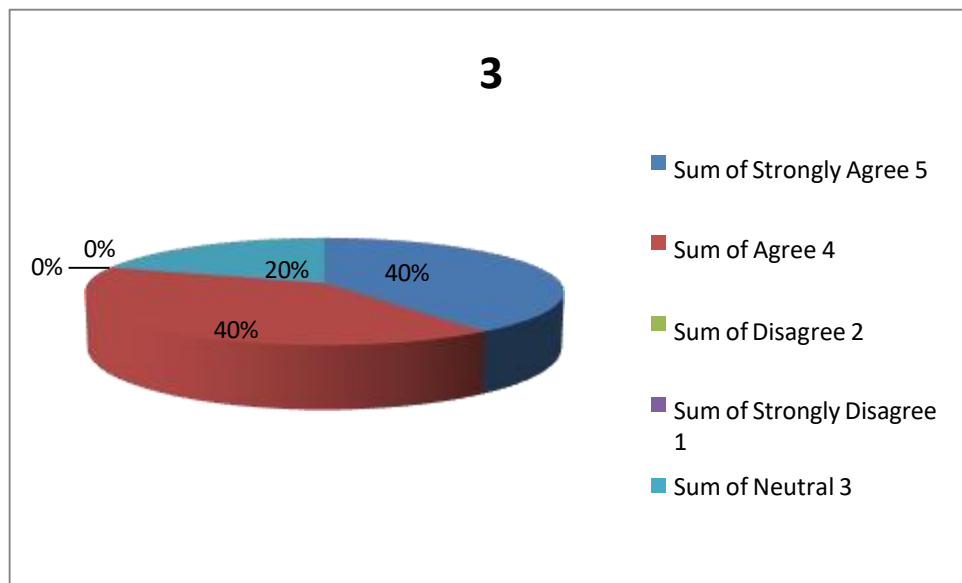


Figure 3 - Percentage of responses of employers about Using technology and workplace equipment

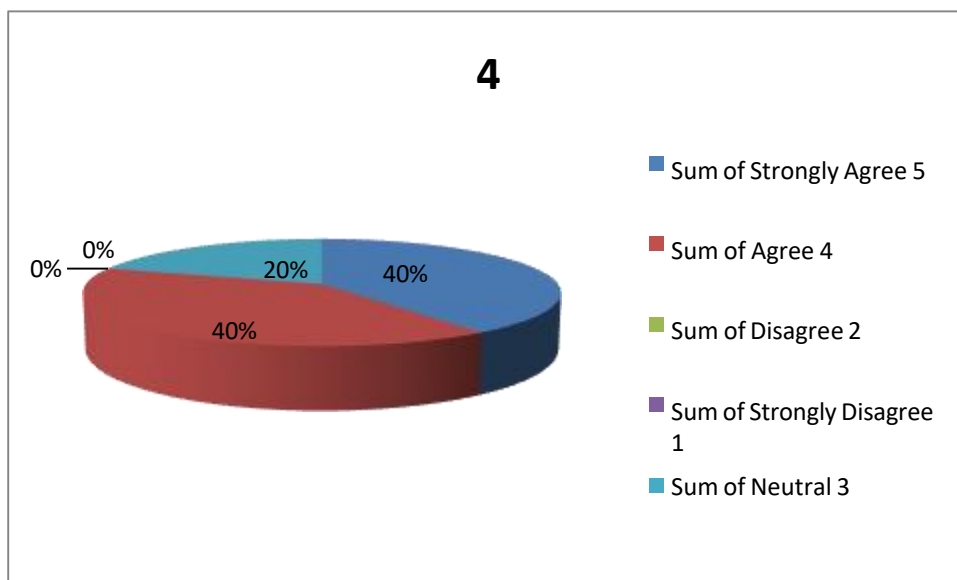


Figure 4 - Percentage of responses of employers about Ability to contribute to the goal of the organization.

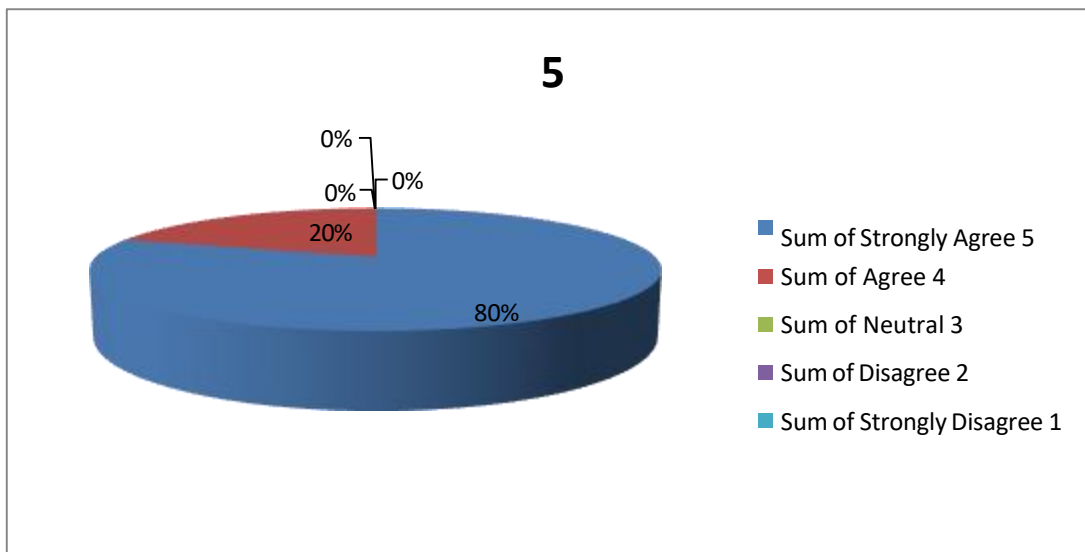


Figure 5 - Percentage of responses of employers about Involvement in social activities.

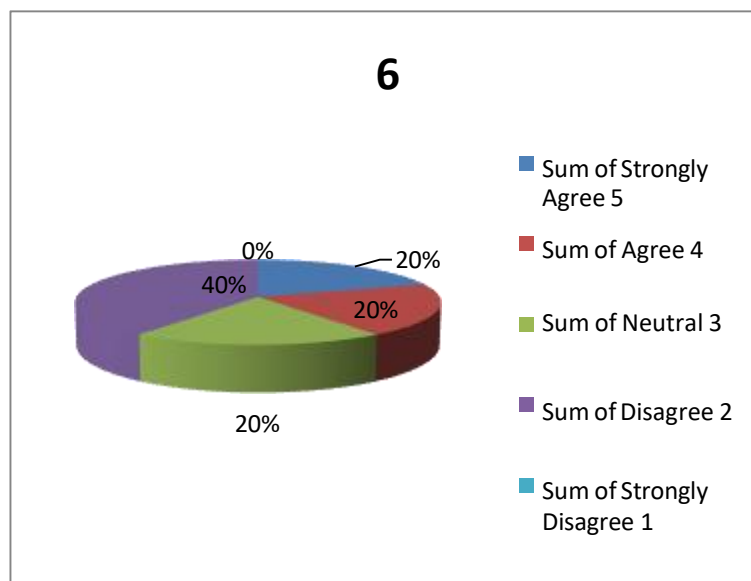


Figure 6 - Percentage of responses of employers about Obligation to work beyond schedule if required.

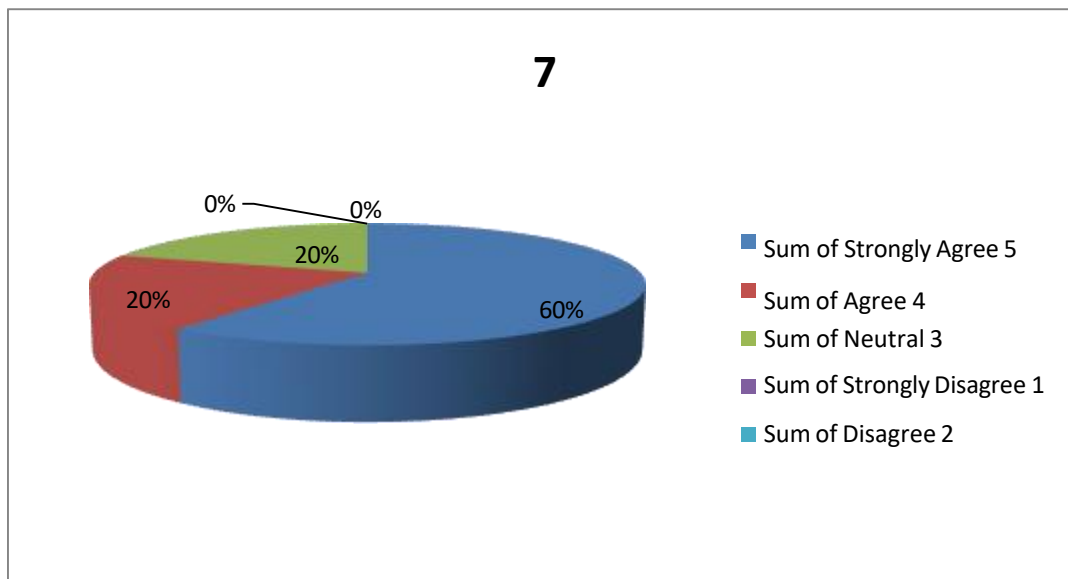


Figure 7 - Percentage of responses of employers about Ability to manage leadership qualities

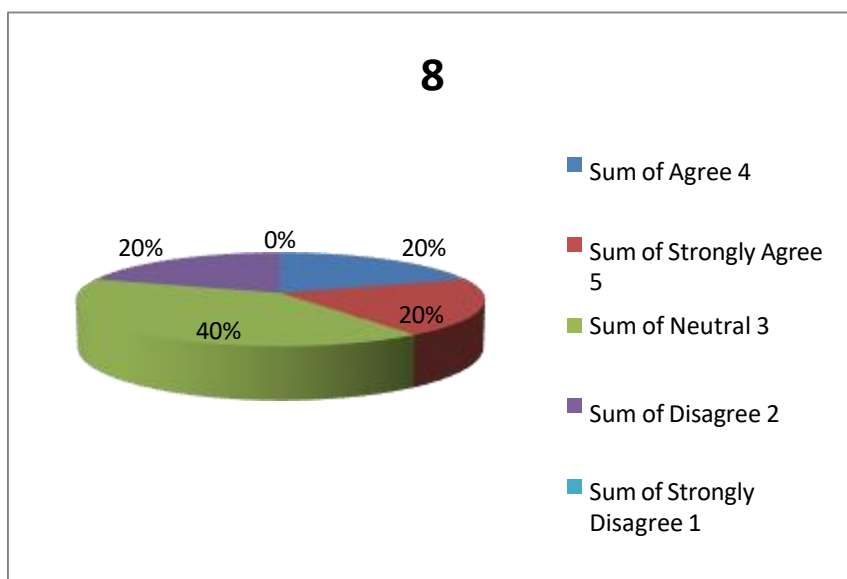


Figure 8 - Percentage of responses of employers about Ability to manage projects in the Multi-disciplinary Environment.

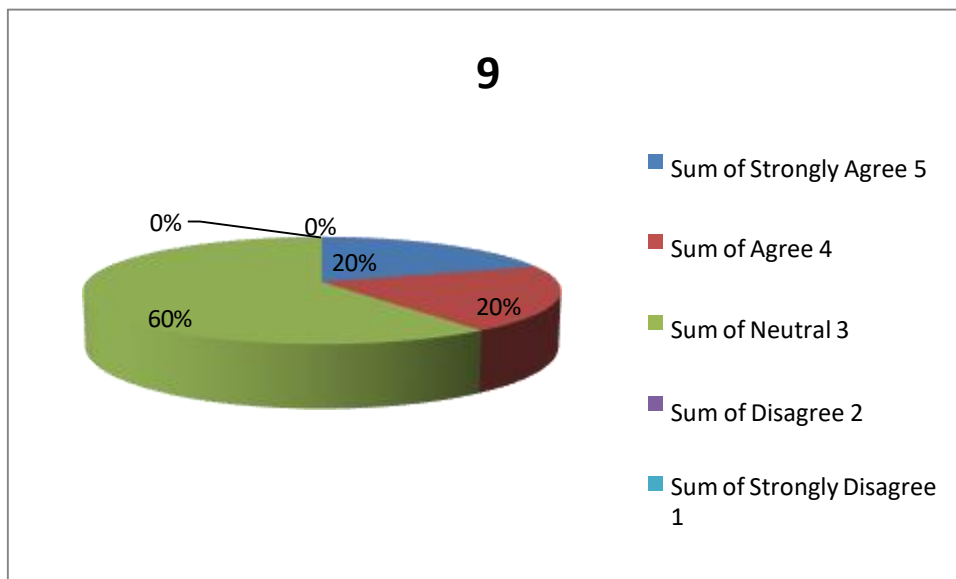


Figure 9 - Percentage of responses of employers about Level of overall performance of the graduate towards organizational growth.

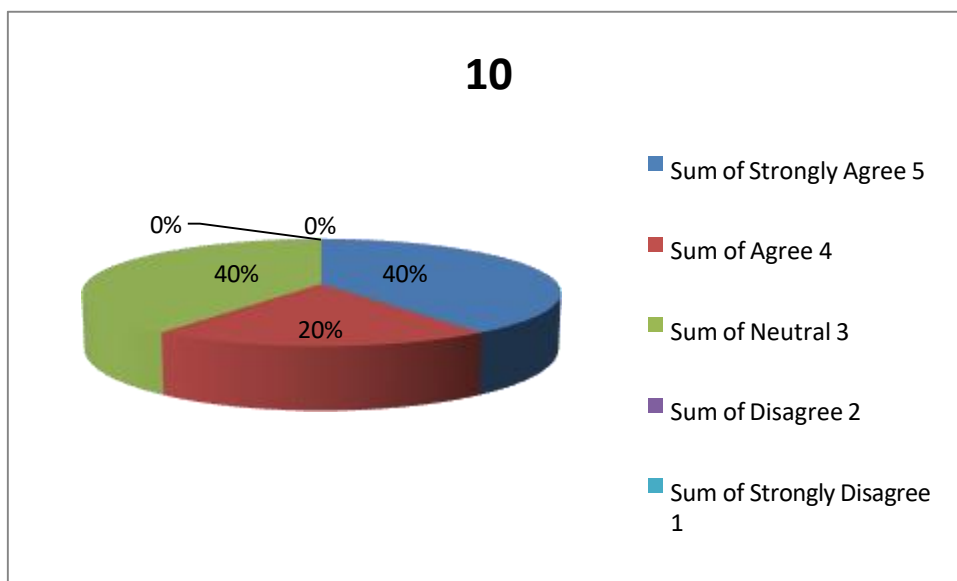


Figure 10 - Percentage of responses of employers about Formative and summative assessment of students.
